- 5. Arrive at NGO train Nagoya Shinkansen Kyoto train Otsu



If you'd like to look around Kyoto city before going to Otsu, you can send your luggage from Kyoto station to the hotel.







Meitetsu Nagoya and JR Nagoya stations are located in different buildings. The map below shows a pathway from the **west gate** of Meitetsu line to JR Shinkansen. You may use north and central gate of Meitetsu station, but there's no elevator. The north ticket gate to Shinkansen is closer to cars for unreserved seats (cars No. 1 through 3).

# From Otsu station to the hotel (hotel shuttle bus)





Leave the station by the North Exit.



Cross a road diagonally forward left.



Go straight for 50 m along the street.





Please wait at the bus stop (blue signboard). Between 8:30AM and 9:00PM, the bus leaves hourly, at 00 and 30 minutes past the hour.

It takes about JPY 1,300 to go to the hotel by taxi.
